QUALIFICATIONS:

This position requires a compassionate, personable, motivated, and organized individual capable of assisting in a variety of project classroom activities. Desirable skills include the ability to assist parents and families with challenges they are addressing, co-teach classes to these parents and/or children and teens utilizing the Nurturing Parenting curriculum, www.nurturingparenting.com, to create a friendly and safe environment and to communicate effectively, verbally and written. Training provided as needed.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

The following duty statements are illustrative of the essential functions of the job and do not include other non-essential or marginal duties that may be required

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Maintain the philosophy, integrity and confidentiality of the Nurturing Parenting Program (NPP).
- Co-facilitate Nurturing Parenting Classes in Chaffee County. This will include assisting with the implementation of lesson plans and agendas based on established curriculum, direct teaching, program set-up, prep and clean-up.
- Provide a safe and supportive environment for children, may include direct supervision of children.
- Support other NPP activities as directed by the Program Coordinator
- Attend all necessary trainings this program requires.
- Refer all relevant family issues to supervising NPP Facilitator.

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE:

Minimum Education: Minimum of 2 years of experience providing teaching, trainings, childcare and/or group facilitation. Knowledge of Child/Family Development and Psychology. Ability to work independently, lead and manage projects and be an effective team member. Flexible schedule necessary for parenting classes, and other evening/weekend activities. Knowledge of family programs, preferably NPP, is preferred.

REPORTING RELATIONSHIPS:

This Position Reports to: Nurturing Parenting Program Coordinator and the Manager of Family and Youth Initiatives.

This Position has Management responsibility for: NPP teen volunteers who support the classes.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- Ability to communicate verbally and in writing in a clear and concise manner
- Ability to interact with the public in a professional and positive manner
- Knowledge of community resources for NPP families

SCOPE OF INTERPERSONAL CONTACTS:

Relationships are with families with complex needs. At times the position may require reaching out to community resources such as probation, Sol Vista Mental Health, and faithbased organizations.

MATERIAL AND EQUIPMENT USED:

Computer, printer, fax, copy machine, telephone, and other office equipment, kitchen equipment including ovens, stoves, sinks, dish washers.

WORK ENVIRONMENT:

Work includes a standard office environment, classroom setting and family's homes.

Employee may be exposed to:

- Conditions such as fumes, noxious odors, dusts, mists, gases, and poor ventilation that affect the respiratory system, eyes, or the skin.
- Varying weather conditions
- Possible bodily injury from classroom activities, transportation accidents, moving mechanical parts of equipment, tools, or machinery.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

The following are some of the physical demands commonly associated with this position.

Mobility:

- Stands 50% of the time, walks 10% of the time, and sits 40% of the time.
- Ascends or descends ladders, stairs, scaffolding, ramps, poles, and the like using feet and legs or hands and arms.
- Maintains body equilibrium to prevent falling when walking, standing, crouching, or running on narrow, slippery, or erratically moving surfaces.

- Bends body downward and forward by bending spine at the waist, requiring full use of the lower extremities and back muscles.
- Bends legs at knees to come to rest on knee or knees.
- Bends body downward and forward by bending legs and spine.
- Reaches, extending hand(s) in any direction.

Lifting:

Exerts 20 to 25 pounds of force occasionally, or 10 to 25 pounds of force frequently, or greater than a negligible amount up to 10 pounds of force constantly to move objects.

Dexterity:

- Handles, seizes, holds, grasps, turns, or otherwise works with hand or hands.
- Fingers, picks up, pinches, or otherwise works primarily with fingers rather than with the whole hand or arm.

Vision:

The vision requirements for this position are as follows:

- Close vision (clear at 20 inches or less).
- Distance vision (clear at 20 feet or more).
- Color vision (ability to identify and distinguish colors).
- Peripheral vision (ability to observe an area that can be seen up and down or to the left or right while eyes are fixed at a given point).

Communications: Individual must be able to clearly understand the English language and be understood while speaking the English language. Bi-lingual capability in Spanish a plus.
